

Ministry News from the Mullins

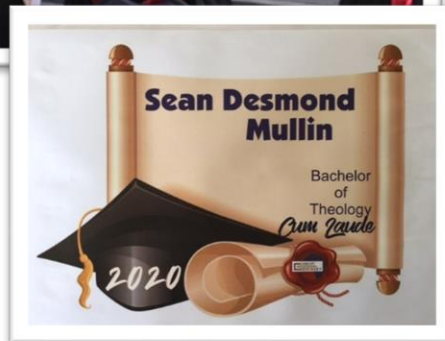
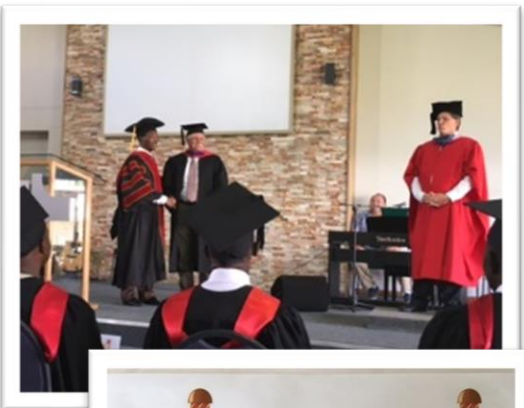
